Dear Prospective Member:

As our name indicates, we are a 35-acre club located in Pickaway County, east of Circleville on US Route 22. We are located about 45 minutes from downtown Columbus and 5 minutes from Circleville. We are 1.7 miles east of Ohio Christian University on the north side of US Route 22.

We have an active club with many activities throughout the year. PCSI recognizes that youth are an important part of keeping our sporting heritage alive, thus we have a variety of youth oriented programs and activities in addition to our regular programs.

PCSI has several ranges. We have a 100 yard rifle range with covered shooting positions, a “bunkered” range (with berms at 25, 50, 75 and 100 yards), a 25 yard falling plate pistol range, a 25 yard moving target range and two additional 25 yard pistol ranges (one with some 50 yard positions). We also have a clubhouse, shelter house, picnic areas, a fishing pond, a primitive camping area, and an archery practice area.

PCSI has several divisions that hold matches for fun and competition (you do not have to be a member to compete). These include USPSA-IPSC, American Steel Plate, IHMSA Silhouette, USPSA-Multigun, Action Pistol, IDPA, SASS-Cowboy Action, Shotgun Sports, and CMP high power rifle matches, and others. We also have a Junior 22 rifle program, annual Youth Day, and hold an open house for National Hunting and Fishing Day, and many other programs open to the public.

PCSI holds its General Membership meetings at 7:30 pm on the third Thursday of each month, except December. Prospective members are urged to attend some of our meetings and read our Policy & Procedures manual that is available on our website under “Forms & Documents”.

We are a private club and our membership is capped at four hundred (400) members. New members are accepted in the club in early March if there are any open membership slots. If there are more prospective members than open slots we revert to a lottery system.

What you, as a prospective member, need to know:

- * NRA membership is mandatory; you may join/renew through the Club at a reduced rate.
- * You **MUST** be sponsored by a present member in good standing.
- * You must attend a mandatory two-hour safety/orientation class.
- * Currently, membership costs one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for the first year as a new member and one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for subsequent years. You may reduce your yearly dues to fifty (\$50.00) by becoming an “active” member. An active member is one who has earned 100 “work points” by the General Membership meeting in October. There are plenty of opportunities to earn work points throughout the year. Points are earned for attending meetings, scheduled work sessions, and helping at special events, such as Youth Day. The “work” in work points is not always physical; there are many opportunities to earn work points throughout the year.
- * New members are **REQUIRED** to earn thirty (30) work points minimum by the October General Meeting to be eligible to renew for their second year.

When you have fulfilled all of the pre-requisites and paid your first year dues (cash/check only) you will be issued a photo I.D. and the combination to the front gate, which changes every January 1st.
